### Who we are

The **Coalition to Protect the Rights of New York's Dually Eligible (CPRNYDE)** is a diverse group of consumer-based interests, agencies, and perspectives joining forces to shape the programs that coordinate care for 760,000 older and/or disabled New Yorkers who are dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid. CPRNYDE works to ensure that the state's population of dual eligibles—people enrolled in both Medicare and Medicaid—receive quality long term care, with an emphasis on New York's Managed Long-Term Care (MLTC) and Fully Integrated Duals Advantage (FIDA) programs.

### What we will do

CPRNYDE wants to talk to dual eligible New Yorkers who receive long term care services or who may need them in the future, and their caregivers, in order to:

- **Learn** about their experiences and what they want from their managed care plans;
- **Empower** dual eligibles to know how to advocate for themselves and others, and to be aware of their rights;
